CPS Dismantling Action Checklist

Learn your state's CPS laws and your parental rights

Refuse entry unless a court order is presented

Never sign a safety plan without legal review

Document every interaction (names, dates, statements)

Connect with other affected parents in your area

Create or join a public record of unethical CPS behavior

Speak to your child about school-based CPS visits

Submit FOIA requests to your state CPS office

Attend local court hearings and speak up publicly

Support or initiate lawsuits demanding policy change
